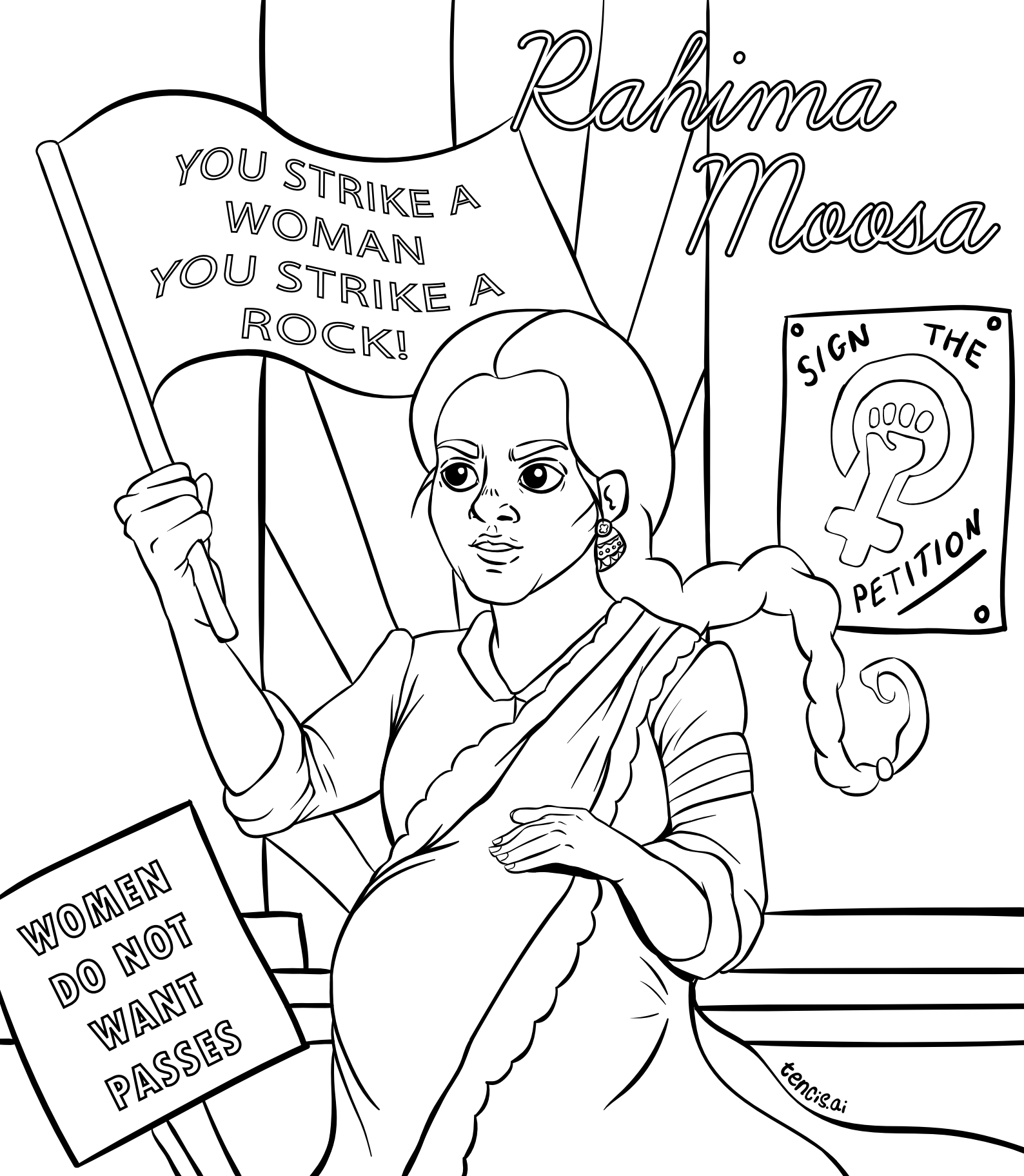


Rahima Maosa



Rahima and her identical twin sister Fatima were born in 1922. They both became politically active as teenagers, after becoming aware of the unjust segregation laws in South Africa. Together with Helen Joseph, Lilian Ngoyi and Sophia Williams-de Bruyn, Rahima spearheaded the historic **march to the Union Buildings** on 9 August 1956 where women handed over petitions against pass laws.
